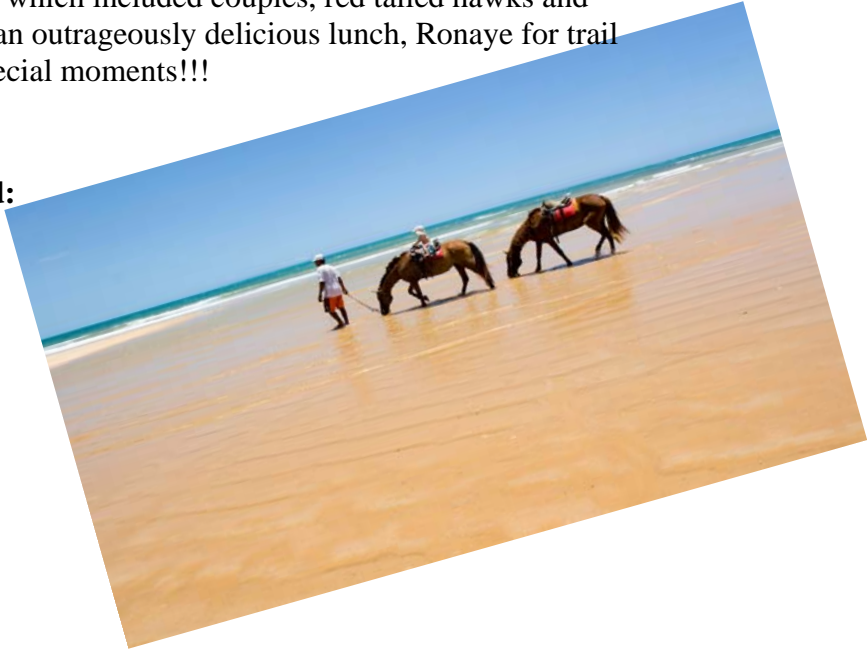
From Agua Dulce: Take Sierra Hwy east. Turn left on Red Rover, left on Ave. V. House on top of hill.
